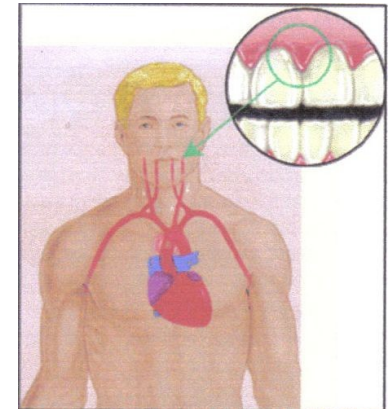

- **Pregnancy: Preterm, Low Birth Weight Babies & Periodontal Disease**

Growing evidence suggest a link between periodontal disease and premature, low birth weight births. Pregnant women who have gum disease may be more likely to have a baby that is born too early and too small. Learn how periodontal disease may affect pregnancy outcomes.

- **The Relationship Between Heart Attack/Stroke and Periodontal Disease**

Recent studies suggest that people with periodontitis may have nearly twice the risk of having a fatal heart attack as those without periodontitis. Learn the relationship between these two diseases.

- **Periodontal Disease and Diabetes: Two Sides of the Coin**

Evidence consistently shows that diabetes is a risk factor for increased severity of gingivitis and periodontitis. Conversely, periodontitis can be a risk factor for worsening glycemic control in patients with diabetes, and may increase the risk for diabetic complications.

- **Periodontal Treatment Planning**

An estimated 80 percent of American adults currently have some form of periodontal disease. We will discuss the disease from mild to severe and how to develop a treatment plan for each.
