Summary:

Graduation Requirements for the BS in Electronics Technology at SDSU:

Total number of credits at SDSU: 86

Transfer credits from LATI*: 34

Total credits required: 120

*Transferable general education course credits can be completed at LATI to a maximum of 60 transferrable credits.

Upon successful completion of the major requirements specified below, SDSU will accept 34 technical course credits from the A.A.S. degree in Electronics Systems Technology for students majoring in Electronics Technology. Students must successfully complete the A.A.S. degree in Electronics Systems Technology from LATI prior to transferring to SDSU for the technical course credits to be accepted. General Education coursework is in addition to the 34 technical course credits. Students must meet all Board of Regents policies and university graduation requirements in order to receive a degree.
