



2017-2018 TOOL PROGRAM REMINDER

Tools are a very expensive upfront cost. (See examples below.) We want to make sure you are budgeting for this. Typically most third party entities such as National Guard, GI Bill, and Department of Labor are not able to assist in covering tool costs. Perhaps you have a plan in place (e.g., graduation money, gift from parents or grandparents, personal savings, etc.) and that's great! **If you don't**

have a plan, here are some suggestions:

Direct PLUS (for dependent students who are required to provide parent information on FAFSA) – This is a loan your parent would borrow from the federal government on your behalf. The parent is responsible for repayment. Parent can borrow Estimated Budget minus other aid. Repayment will begin within 60 days after the last disbursement of the loan. A loan origination fee will be deducted from each disbursement. A credit evaluation is required. Information is available from the LATI Financial Aid office or on the LATI website at www.lakeareatech.edu under the Financial Aid/Financial Information section -- scroll down to *Parents*.

Private Loan – This is a loan the student would borrow. Most will require a credit worthy co-signer. Several lenders offer Private Loans to our students through their own private loan programs. Information is available from the LATI Financial Aid Office or on the LATI website at www.lakeareatech.edu under the Financial Aid/Financial Aid Information section -- scroll down to *Private Alternative Loans*.

Diesel Technology/DCAT	\$8,000 to \$10,000
Custom Paint & Fab	\$5,000 to \$7,000
