1. 30 credit hours toward the master's degree prerequisite requirements.

The student must complete the remaining prerequisite coursework at DWU or another institution PRIOR to admission into the DWU MAT. See below for details on the articulation plan of study.

Other pre-requisite requirements include a minimum of 3.0 GPA in all pre-requisite courses and 50 hours of observation under a certified athletic trainer.
