**Graduation Requirements for the BS in Agricultural Education at SDSU:**

**Total number of credits at SDSU:** 91\*\*\*

**Transfer credits from LATI:** 29\*\*\*

(Required BOR system general education credits: 6\*\*\*)

(Block credits: 23)

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**Total credits required:** 120

\*\*\*Six credits (SPCM 101 and ECON 201) of transferable general education courses are required for Agriculture: Agri-Business Option at LATI. Additional transferable general education credits can be completed at LATI which could reduce the number of credits needed at SDSU. However, no more than 60 credits total can be transferred from LATI to SDSU.

Upon successful completion of the major requirements specified, SDSU will accept 23 technical course credits and 6 required general education credits from the A.A.S. degree in Agriculture: Agri-Business option for students majoring in Agricultural Education, Communication, and Leadership: Education Specialization. Students must successfully complete the A.A.S. degree in Agriculture Business from LATI prior to transferring to SDSU for the technical course credits to be accepted. General Education coursework completed at LATI is in addition to the technical course credits. Students must meet all Board of Regents policies and university graduation requirements in order to receive a degree.
