### **Hybrid E-Degree**

To fill the increasing need in South Dakota and the surrounding area, Lake Area Tech offers the Medical Laboratory Technician E-Degree to individuals residing in South Dakota, and the bordering states,; North Dakota, Minnesota, Iowa and Nebraska. Due to travel required for labs at LATC, the online option is most successful for those living within 3-4 hours of our campus.

Lectures and assignments are available online with tests administered by acceptable proctors. Labs are held monthly at LATC. Approximately 8 hours of lab will be required for every MLT credit taken. For example, for a 4 credit class will you will spend about 32 hours in labs on campus. A lab schedule will be sent at the start of each semester so all online students can make plans for their attendance at these mandatory labs.

MLT specific coursework via a part time rotational schedule will begin after prerequisite courses have been completed. At this time you will complete four semesters of part-time enrollment followed by one semester of full-time clinical practicum at an approved clinical site. Clinical will begin after all prerequisites and MLT classes have been completed successfully.
