

TRANSFER OF CREDIT FOR AN OTA COURSE

At this time, the only OTA courses that will receive a transfer of credit are OTA 120 Human Development: Prenatal through Adolescence (2 credits) and OTA 200 Human Development: Adult to Death (1 credit). To receive transfer credit for these courses the student must submit a transcript from an educational institution meeting the requirements of LATI's transfer of credit policy for general education and related courses documenting the completion of a human development course with a grade of C or higher and a syllabus of the course. The course syllabus must document the following topics for full credit to be received.

- 1) Age groups covered Prenatal, Toddler, Preschool, School Age, Adolescent, Young Adult, Middle Adult, Older Adult, Death
- 2) Types of development: physical, cognitive, psychosocial/social emotional

The OTA Program Director will review the syllabi and determine if full transfer of credit or partial transfer of credit is appropriate.
